MatBlas Ltd ("us", "we", or "our") uses cookies on the www.insurance-digest.com website (the "Service"). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies.

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

1. What are cookies

1.1. Cookies are small pieces of text sent to your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

1.2. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when you go offline, while session cookies are deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

2. How MatBlas Ltd uses cookies

2.1. When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser.

2.2. We use cookies for the following purposes:

- To enable certain functions of the Service
- To provide analytics

2.3. We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service:

- **Essential cookies.** We may use cookies to remember information that changes the way the Service behaves or looks, such as a user's language preference on the Service.
- **Analytics cookies.** We may use analytics cookies to track information how the Service is used so that we can make improvements. We may also use analytics cookies to test new advertisements, pages, features or new functionality of the Service to see how our users react to them.
- **Account holders.** For users that register on our website (if any), we also store the personal information they provide in their user profile. All users can see, edit, or delete their personal information at any time. Website administrators can also see and edit that information upon request.

3. What rights you have over your data

3.1. If you have an account on this site, or have left comments, you can request to receive an exported file of the personal data we hold about you, including any data you have provided to us. You can also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes.

4. Cookies we use

- 4.1. **Session ID:** These cookies are used to track your browsers unique session on our website.
- 4.2. **Shopping Cart:** When you add an item to your cart, that information is temporarily stored in a cookie until you pay for your order. This cookie contains information such as the product you are ordering, the quantity, and any additional product specific configuration data.

4.3. **Customer ID:** If you login we may track your Customer ID via a cookie. Your Customer ID is a unique number in our database that outside of The P&C Insurance Digest™ does not personally identify you.

4.4. **Current Training:** If you access training or digital files via our system, we may store a reference to the current content you are viewing which we use for security purposes.

4.5. **Google Analytics Cookies:** These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form.

4.6. **Tawk Live Chat:** These cookies are used track live chat sessions on our website. No personal information is stored or shared unless you start or respond to a live chat message.

4.7. Third-party cookies

4.7.1. In addition to our own cookies, we may also use various third-parties cookies to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service, and so on.

4.7.2. Embedded content from other websites: Courses on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

4.7.3. These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

5. Google Analytics

5.1. Google Analytics is a web analytics service offered by Google that tracks and reports website traffic. Google uses the data collected to track and monitor the use of our Service. This data is shared with other Google services. Google may use the collected data to contextualise and personalise the ads of its own advertising network.

5.2. We have implemented reCAPTCHA on the website and its use is subject to the Google [Privacy Policy](#) and [Terms of Use](#). reCAPTCHA may is only used to fight spam and abuse on the website. reCAPTCHA is not be used for any other purposes such as determining credit worthiness, employment eligibility, financial status, or insurability of a user.
